Dear Sir, madam,

We refer to your enquiry about suspension and locking following five domains due to suspicions to be rogue pharmacies:



We have investigated the possible approaches and possible legal consequences regarding your enquiry. We understand your aim and you have our full respect. Nevertheless it will not be possible for us to comply with your request due to legal reasons. We are bound to respect legal regulations of Czech Republic and European Union and contractual duties towards our clients.

Your enquiry in fact means that we as a private corporation in order to facilitate (public) law enforcement would block domains names on bases of an enquiry without any legal authority. If there is a pressing social need for specific legal action against possible rouge pharmacies it is up to national governments to introduce legislation that meets such demands or to engage law enforcement.

Our legislation regarding free competition on free market would most definitely protect our clients from any our attempt to illegally or illegitimately block or suspend their sites unless requested by competent legal authority. The principle of free movement of goods and services within the European Union, of which the Czech Republic is a member, must be emphasised.

Under free trade and EU rules, this manner of reviewing “legal” distribution channels would not hold water.

We are of the opinion our interference in the business of such an entity would be regarded illegal and illegitimate.

We may not judge which legal opinion in this case is correct – if it is yours or if it is our clients. Any action we could take must be strictly based upon an order or request by a state authority informing you of the fact that operation of the site is illegal. Therefore in this case we have to wait until a competent authority claims such request based on legal proceedings.

We understand that you cooperate with legal authorities in the U.S., therefore we will await the results of formal legal proceedings regarding the suspicion you have raised in your enquiry.

We are sorry we could not be of any further assistance.
